



Enrolment Scheme Changes

Golden Sands Primary School 2022

Mount Maunganui and Papamoa School Growth

Currently all of our schools in these catchments are at, or over capacity. The provision of a new primary school to open in term 1, 2022 and new classrooms at many schools will alleviate some of the growth pressure. Changes to existing enrolment schemes will also ease pressure across the network of schools.

What is an enrolment scheme?

When a school is at or close to capacity, the potential for overcrowding needs to be addressed. Enrolment schemes help manage overcrowding and ensure local students can attend schools in their area.

Amending an enrolment scheme

The existing enrolment scheme for Golden Sands Primary School needs an amendment to the home zone for the school to avoid future overcrowding at the school, and to ease pressure on the wider network of state schools.

New Enrolment Zones

The following 8 zones in Tauranga have been consulted on and are being introduced in 2022.



Amended Enrolment Zone

The amended enrolment zone for Golden Sands Primary School removes the current overlap with the Papamoa Primary School zone, and is being reduced in size following the opening of two new schools. This will allow the Boards of Trustees to manage their roll numbers more effectively. See reverse for map and description.

Frequently Asked Questions:

We are now out of zone, will my son/daughter be affected?

- Currently enrolled students are not affected by any changes to the enrolment zone.

Are siblings of current students who are now out of zone affected?

- No, siblings of current students are treated as in zone for 6 years until 2028.

Zone Description

The enrolment zone boundary starts at the northern exit of the beach access way running between 2B Taylor Road and 1B Motiti Road and travels south-east along the shoreline to the mouth of the Kaituna River.

The boundary then follows the Kaituna River south, to the Tauranga Eastern Link (SH2) bridge.

The zone then travels northward along the middle of Tauranga Eastern Link (SH2) to the eastern boundary of 138 Union Drive (this address is excluded from the zone). The boundary travels north, to the round about of Union Drive, Stevenson Drive, and Te Okuroa Drive.

The boundary travels west, along the centre of Te Okuroa Drive, capturing odd-numbered addresses only, to the roundabout of Te Okuroa Drive and Monticola Drive.

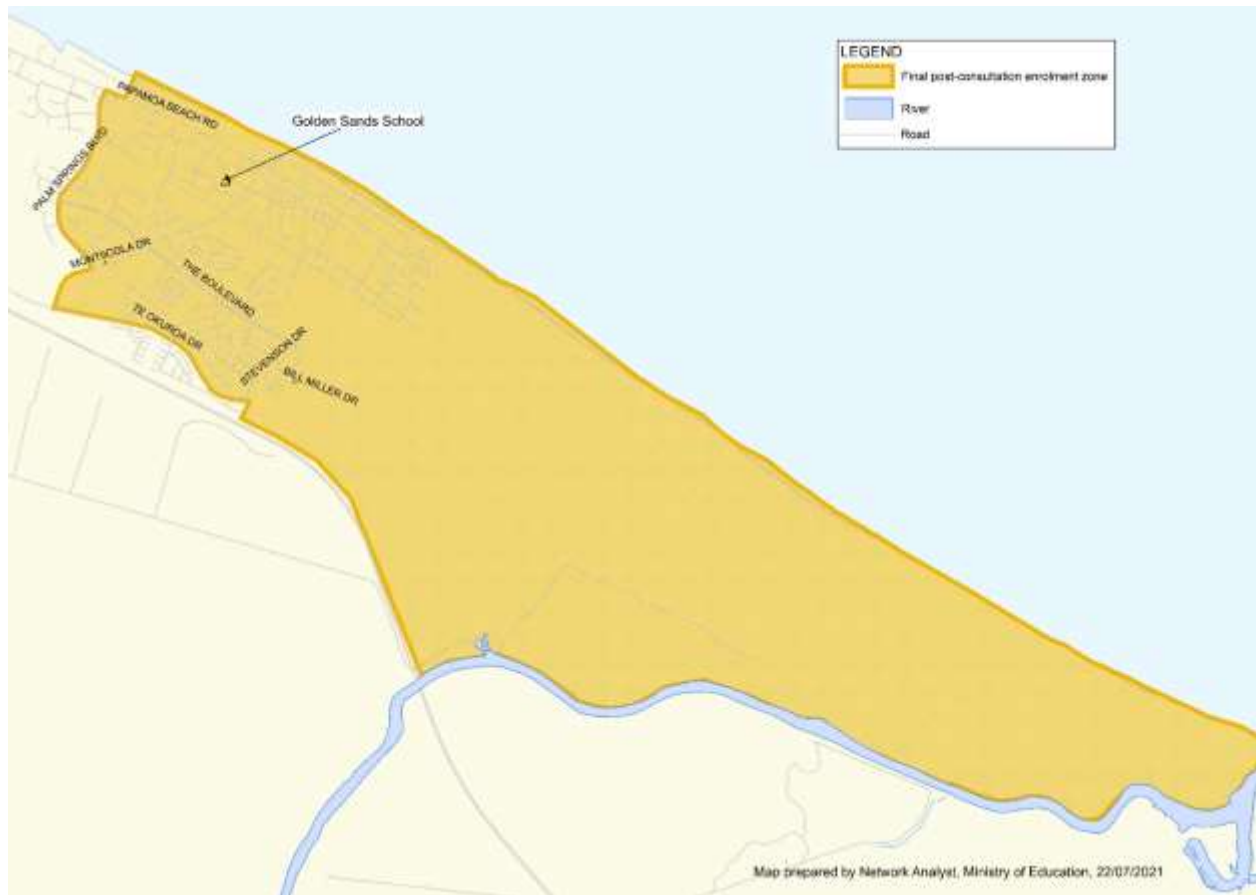
The boundary travels north-east, along the centre of Monticola Drive, capturing even-numbered addresses only, to the roundabout of Monticola Drive, Colpoma Cres and Palm Springs Boulevard.

The boundary travels northward, along the centre of Palm Springs Boulevard, and capturing odd-numbered addresses only, to the intersection of Palm Springs Boulevard and Papamoa Beach Road.

The boundary travels along the centre of Papamoa Beach Road, capturing even-numbered addresses only, to the intersection with Motiti Road.

The boundary crosses into Motiti Road, and to the beach accessway running between 2B Taylor Road and 1B Motiti Road.
